You may recall the headline story at the end of 2018 of Washington state social worker Alan Naiman who, a man of perceived little wealth bequeathed nearly \$11 Million to charities.

The beneficiaries of Mr. Naiman's estate had no indication of their forthcoming inheritance and for most recipients; the bequest received was life-changing to the organization's work. For one organization, Mr. Naiman's gift eliminated their mortgage. Another organization, receiving a gift greater than one year of their operating budget was able to immediately implement plans that would have otherwise taken years to make reality.

To impact so many worthy organizations as Alan did is inspiring and is a dream of nonprofits everywhere. For us at the Foundation, this spectacular story of unexpected generosity reminds us that for every philanthropist that reaches out to our Foundation for assistance in estate planning, there are many more that have the same aspirations and just need some guidance to ensure their bequest wishes are honored.
