How does the program work?

There are two elements to this new program. First and foremost we will be asking community members to donate new clothes for elementary age school children when they start school in the fall. Secondly we have started an endowment fund to help subsidize the purchase of additional clothes so we can help even more children. So there are two ways you can help:

What is the process? All County Schools are invited to participate (Ayersville, Defiance, Fairview, Hicksville, Tinora, as well as Good Samaritan, Holy Cross and St. John's Lutheran). The schools will be contacted shortly after school begins each fall to determine the need. The goals are as follows:

- To invite community members to purchase a new outfit for those children in need.
- To provide these items in an atmosphere of anonymity so the purchasers of the items do not know the students names and vice versa.
- To handle gifts of clothing in such a way that other students are not aware of the "gifts".
- To finish the project as soon as possible after school starts each fall.

NOTE: The students are selected by representatives from each school system.
