Tonya and Rodney Wichman recently established The Election Ambassador Scholarship Program. The Election Ambassador program is set up to assist students to learn about their local government, how elections are run and participate in the election process.

The Election Ambassadors will work with already engaged teachers at each local high school in searching for student poll workers, assisting in voter registration and work with the office in providing an election in Defiance County. High school juniors and seniors that participate will be eligible for a \$250 scholarship to a university or trade school.

"The program came from searching for a silver lining in all of the election information being shared over the past few years. A realization arose that we were missing an opportunity to educate the community on how elections are actually run, especially at a local level," said Tonya.

"We hope that this program will also engage the Ambassadors classmates, friends and family in the learning process. This is an opportunity for our Ambassadors to experience what will be needed to become a future leader of the community while gaining a resource to further their education."
