The Defiance Dream Center's workforce development program is built upon our passion to holistically meet the needs of individuals in our community.

Our program is different from others because we infuse foundational elements of our life coaching program into the training. This infusion acts as a bedrock for character development, empowerment to achieve desired goals and reinforcement through consistent encouragement.

We partner with Northwest State Community College, Ohio Means Jobs, Defiance County Economic Development

and now Defiance High School to bring in demand training to many learners who have historically been overlooked or viewed as unwilling to learn.



We currently offer training in three different educational tiers focused on automotive, construction trades and welding. We hope to launch an administrative support and customer service training curriculum in 2022. Since delving into the area of workforce development in mid-2018 the Defiance Dream Center has helped 65 individuals

find employment and/or receive job-readiness training.

Thanks to the support of the Defiance Area
Foundation our first high school class graduated from
our program in May 2021. Six young men were
identified by Principal Jerger and Superintendent
Morton as candidates for our program because of
their belief these young men could excel in our nontraditional educational setting where a hands-on
approach to learning is the primary vehicle to
achievement. These six young men earned high
school credit from DHS in Construction Skills Basic

Training and a Lean Six Sigma Yellow Belt from N.S.C.C. while also receiving proclamations from Senator Rob McColley and Representative Craig Riedel. Article and photos provided by Defiance Dream Center
