The Northeastern Local Schools Donor Advised Fund was recently established through The Defiance Area Foundation. This fund will be used for charitable, scientific and educational purposes and provide broader educational service opportunities.

Three sub-funds will be established and including an Endowment Fund, a Scholarship Fund, and a fund for Capital Projects. Donations to any of these funds may be made with gifts of cash, stock/mutual funds, and bequests.

Distributions from the fund will be granted to the School or other charitable organizations to benefit Northeastern Local Schools. A committee of community supporters, along with school administration will oversee grants from the fund.

Defiance City School Foundation Launches Annual Appeal

The Defiance City Schools Foundation (DCSF) maintains a pool of endowed funds in support of the Foundation's philanthropic activities. Gifts to the DCSF Annual Appeal are added to the general fund, as designated by donors. The DCSF fund value as of 8/31/21 is \$1,034,859. Last year, \$17,413 were awarded as mini-grants to provide supplemental materials for teachers. \$13,880 was granted as scholarships to Defiance High School graduates. Our goal for the 2021 Annual Appeal is \$30,000.
